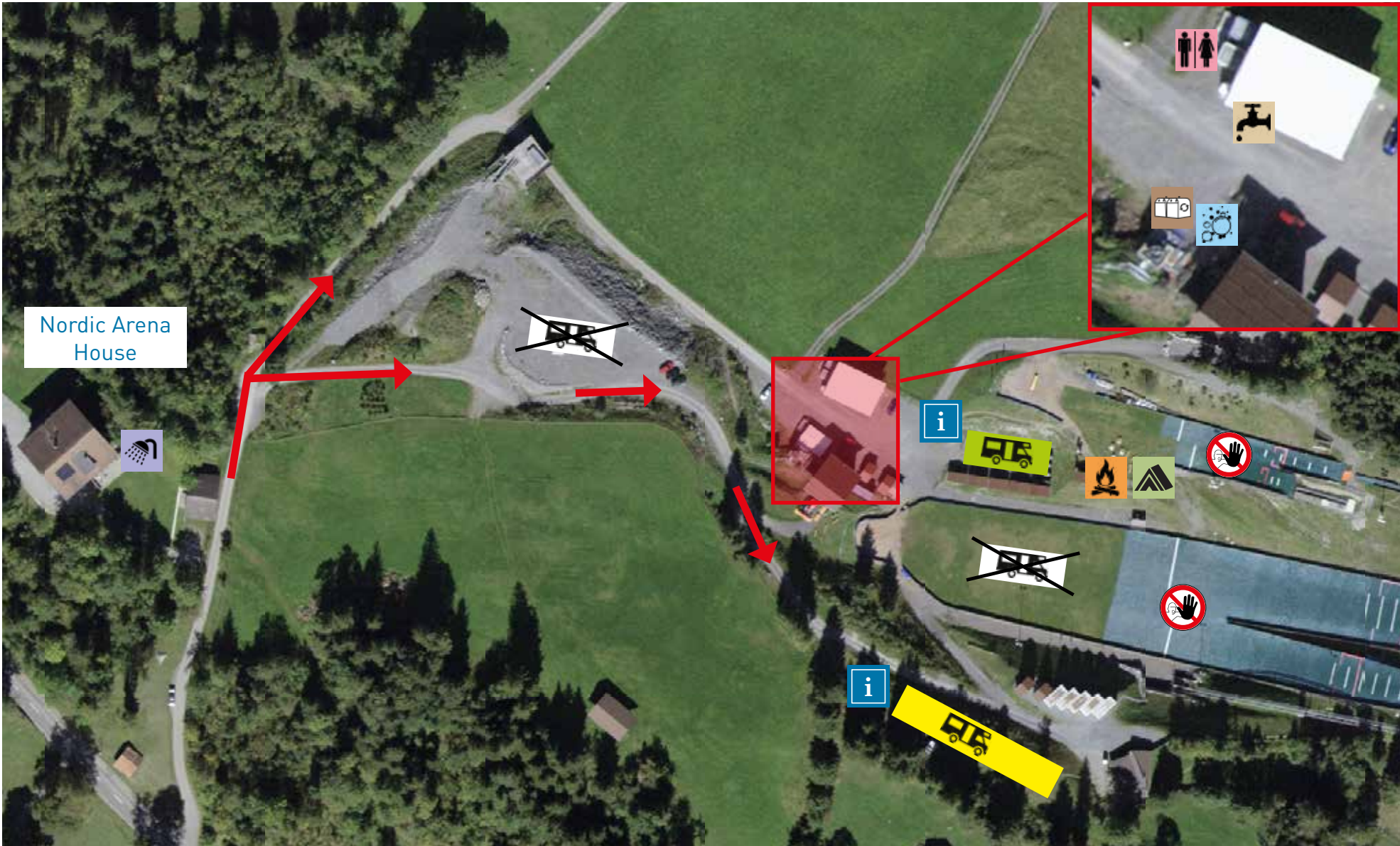




# Information parking spaces



Dear guests, welcome.  
Below you will find all the important information about your stay in the Swisscom Nordic Arena. Thank you for observing our rules of conduct.  
Our parking spaces are suitable for winter use. However, in early winter you must expect the snow cannons to start in the middle of the night and/or run continuously.  
We wish you a pleasant stay and relaxing holidays.

## Rules of conduct

Only the two marked areas are to be used as parking spaces (yellow and green). Please do not park or camp in other free spaces!  
Entering or sliding down the ski jumps is strictly prohibited. All liability is excluded. Please take care of your children.  
Entering the properties of our neighbours is forbidden.  
Leave the parking spaces as you found them.  
Dispose of any waste in the designated waste stations.  
Only light fires in the official barbecue area.  
Emptying of grey and black water is not permitted.  
Please be silent and respect the night rest between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.  
Dogs must be kept on a leash.

## Check-In and Check-Out

You can check in yourself. Choose a pitch and pay for it according to the information under «Payment». We ask you to leave the parking space by 12.00 noon at the latest on the day of departure. The parking fee from 12.00 noon is a flat rate of CHF/EUR 10.00 if you wish to leave your vehicle here until 6.00 p.m. at the latest. You can also pay the day parking according to «Payment».

## Payment

A fee of **CHF 35.– / EUR 40.– per night and vehicle or tent** (including visitor's tax / Please no Euro coins) must be paid for the use of the parking spaces, toilets and drinking water. The entire revenue from the overnight stays is used for the operation of the ski jumping facility and thus for the next generation of ski jumpers. The following options are available for payment:

Cash:	Fill in the visitor's tax form on the the envelope, put the amount inside and put the envelope in the white letterbox.	
TWINT:	Pay using the QR code (right side), fill in the visitor's tax form on the envelope and drop it in the white letterbox. TWINT only works with a Swiss bank account.	
Credit Card:	Register using <b>Parkn'sleep (No app download necessary, see sticker on the letterbox)</b> and book your pitch online. Filling in the visitor's tax form is not necessary.	

There are daily controls by our staff.
